Dodham Helicopter Yatra

DO DHAM YATRA IS A PILGRIMAGE IN INDIA THAT INVOLVES VISITING TWO SACRED SITES - KEDARNATH AND BADRINATH. IT IS BELIEVED TO BRING SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS AND LIBERATION FROM THE CYCLE OF BIRTH AND DEATH.

Kedarnath is a sacred town and pilgrimage site located in the Rudraprayag district of the northern Indian state of Uttarakhand. It is situated at an altitude of approximately 3,583 meters (11,755 feet) above sea level, in the Garhwal Himalayas.

The Kedarnath temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva, is the main attraction of the town. The temple is believed to have been built in the 8th century by Adi Shankaracharya, and has since been renovated several times. The temple is open to pilgrims from April to November, and is closed during the winter due to heavy snowfall in the region.

Badrinath is a sacred town and pilgrimage site located in the Chamoli district of the northern Indian state of Uttarakhand. It is situated at an altitude of approximately 3,133 meters (10,279 feet) above sea level, in the Garhwal Himalayas.

The Badrinath temple, dedicated to Lord Vishnu, is the main attraction of the town. The temple is believed to have been built in the 8th century by Adi Shankaracharya, and has since been renovated several times. The temple is open to pilgrims from April to November, and is closed during the winter due to heavy snowfall in the region.

The town of Badrinath is also surrounded by several natural hot springs, which are believed to have medicinal properties. These hot springs are a popular attraction for pilgrims and tourists alike.

Dodham Helicopter Yatra Itinerary

DAY 1 - ARRIVAL AT DEHRADUN

- Overnight stay at Hotel (Complementary)

DAY 2 - DEHRADUN TO SERSI > KEDARNATH

- Early morning departure from Sahastradhara helipad in Dehradun to Kedarnath.
- Arrival in Kedarnath and visit to the Kedarnath Temple for darshan.
- In the evening, Fly back to SERSI / PHATA / GUPTKASHI.

Overnight stay — SERSI / PHATA / GUPTKASHI.
